Subject: Environmental clearance under Press Note 17 (1984 series) by SCA-cum-SAC.

This has reference to the application submitted by the industry for expansion of its existing unit for increase in the production capacity to M.S Billet @ 4,50,000MTA , TMT Bars/Wire Rod/MS Round etc @4,50,000 MTA and Pipes & Tubes @ 1,20,000 MTA, after expansion. The case of the industry was considered by the SCA-cum-SAC in its 103rd meeting held on 14.01.2019. In the said meeting, it was decided to grant environmental clearance under Press Note 17 (1984 series) to the industry subject to the conditions as proposed by the member departments.

As such, environmental clearance under Press Note 17 (1984 series) is, hereby, granted, subject to the following conditions as proposed by the member departments:

Conditions by PPCB

1. The industry shall obtain Environmental Clearance under EIA notification dated 14/09/2006, before starting any construction activity at the site of the unit for its expansion project.
2. The industry shall obtain consent to establish (NOC) for its expansion project from the Board before installing any machinery.
3. The industry shall obtain the permission from Central Ground Water Authority (CGWA) for its existing tubewell, for abstraction of additional quantity of ground water.
4. The industry shall recycle the entire quantity of treated wastewater back into the cooling process and no quantity of treated wastewater shall be discharged at any place within or outside its premises, without prior permission of the Board.
5. The industry shall enhance the capacity of the STP to 50 KLD as per the assurance given by it through undertaking.
6. The industry shall not undertake any expansion activity of the unit in the newly purchased land measuring 2.91 acres falling in Vill Akalgarh, Tehsil Nabha, Distt Fatehgarh Sahib, which is situated in Mix Land Use Zone as per drafted Master Plan of Nabha, Distt Patiala without obtaining permission from the Housing and Urban Development Authority/ Department of Town & Country Planning and other Department(s), if any.
7. The industry shall install proper well designed emission collection system with side hood along with proper Air Pollution Control Device (APCD), for control of emission so as to achieve the prescribed standards, before commissioning of its expansion unit.
8. The industry shall get its Air Pollution Control Device alongwith its collection system evaluated from PSCST, Chandigarh regarding efficiency alongwith side hood design and shall also submit completion certificate in this regard.
9. The industry shall strictly follow Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) issued by the PPCB vide letter dated 27.06.2018 for air pollution control in the induction furnace units.

Conditions by DOF

10. The industry shall provide Air pollution control devices and make adequate arrangements to control metallic fumes and dust generated in the process, so that the gases do not spread in the work environment.
11. The industry will provide personal protective equipments to the workers and will ensure that the workers are using the same.
12. The industry will modify its On-Site Emergency Plan, health and safety policy if there is any change in organization, plant and machinery.
13. The industry will provide fire extinguishing equipments as required under rule 66 of Punjab Factory Rules, 1952.
14. The industry shall submit compliance report of the conditions of approval of site to Director of Factories, Punjab before the commissioning of its project.
15. The industry shall be inspected after commissioning of its proposed project to monitor the compliance of conditions of approval of site.
16. The building plans of the factory shall be got approved from Director of Factories, Punjab before starting the construction and any other concerned departments if need be.
17. The industry shall maintain occupational health center as per rule 67.
18. Industry shall comply Factory Act, 1948 and Punjab Factory Act, Rule 1952.
19. Industry shall take all precaution measures while using, transporting storing, cutting and taken into use, any toxic/explosive materials to avoid any mishap.

Conditions by CTP

20. The industry will use additional 13.04 acres land falling in village Bhagwanpura, Tehsil-Amlah, District-Fatehgarh Sahib only as an expansion of already approved/running unit subjected to the grant of CLU permission from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Conditions by IMD

21. The entrepreneur will strictly follow the norms laid down by Central Pollution Control Board and Punjab Pollution Control Board. Waste materials should be stored at an appropriate place in factory well covered rooms and disposed through State's Common Hazardous Waste Disposal Facility.

Conditions by DHS

22. The proposed industry should not pose any health hazard to the people residing in the surrounding areas.
23. The workers and the people in the vicinity should be informed about the hazards involved and methods to be adopted to prevent the harmful effects, if any.
24. First Aid Centres & Occupational Health Centres should be provided, as per requirement, to combat and manage health hazards from the processes.
25. No harmful by product should be allowed to be disposed off outside the plant to keep the surrounding environment free from hazardous effects like wastage.
26. Names and connecting telephone numbers of nearby health institutions should be displayed on the board and made known to all concerned in the vicinity of the plant also.
27. SPM (Suspended Particulate Matter) should not be more than the prescribed limit at any stage to avoid exposure to the people in the vicinity.
28. Periodic inspection by the competent authority of the health department will be undertaken for the enforcement of the stipulated conditions given above. Appropriate action under rules will be taken on infringement of these conditions.

Conditions by CFO

29. The Firm shall scrupulously follow the relevant provisions of the National Building Code Part 3 & 4 and any violation shall result in the withdrawal of this approval with immediate effect. However, final Fire NOC must be obtained from the Department after completion of the building and before occupation

Conditions by DOI

30. The entrepreneur will obtain the NOC/permission from the remaining concerned departments.

Conditions by DOA

31. The entrepreneur will adhere to the pollution control norms of water & soil fixed by Punjab Pollution Control Board and will comply with the undertaking given by it to the Department of Agriculture.

Special condition

32. The industry will obtain prior permission for abstraction of ground water from CGWA / Directorate of Groundwater management, Water Resources Department, Punjab / Competent Authority.

General conditions


33. The industry shall submit compliance report of the conditions of this environmental clearance to the Punjab Pollution Control Board, Patiala, before the commissioning of the project.

34. This site clearance is granted under the Factories Act, 1948 and the rules framed there-under as amended from time to time. The industry will obtain clearances/approvals from other concerned departments under any other Act/rules, if need be.

35. This site clearance from environmental angle is, hereby, granted under Press Note No. 17 (1984 Series). However, the industry will obtain site clearance and approvals from other departments, under any other Act/rules, as the case may be.

36. This site clearance does not preclude the institution of any legal action nor relieve the applicant from any responsibilities or penalties to which the applicant is or may be subjected under the provisions of Factories Act or any other Act/rules.

37. This environmental clearance shall remain valid for a period of five years from the date of its issuance.
